
# Assistive Technology Funding Available

Good news for Maryland families - residents wanting to save for disability-related expenses can use the Achieving a Better Life Experience (ABLE) Program even though MD's ABLE program is still in development. Ohio, Tennessee & Nebraska each have ABLE programs open and available for out of state residents. There will be an option to roll the account into MD's program once it is established. Maryland is expecting to have an ABLE program
